General

2. Information on how to enter and the prize forms part of the terms of entry. Entry into the competition via the Kidsafe Australia Facebook page (<https://www.facebook.com/kidsafeaustralia/>) is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.
3. If there is any inconsistency between these Terms and Conditions and anything else that refers to this competition, these Terms and Conditions will prevail.

Who can enter

4. Entry is open to all residents of Australia except employees and immediate families of the Kidsafe Australia, Safetech Hardware and their associated companies and agencies.
